The Ottawa Crime Stoppers Board recently purchased an S-D2 Intoxilyzer for the Ottawa Police Department, which is a handheld breath alcohol tester for use in the field by patrol officers to assist in DUI enforcement in the community.

The S-D2 Intoxilyzer can also be used as a versatile breath alcohol screener in employment and school settings.

Ottawa Crime Stoppers is a partnership between local citizens and law enforcement agencies and has been in the area for over 22 years, providing cash rewards for anonymous information to solve local crimes. Rewards are paid for providing information leading to the arrest and conviction of the individuals responsible for local crimes.

Crime Stoppers rewards are funded by private donations from the public, such as individuals, businesses, clubs, associations and other organizations.
