THE CITY OF OTTAWA HAS ANNOUNCED THAT CONTRACTORS ARE READY TO BEGIN WORK ON THE POST STREET BRIDGE THAT CROSSES OVER GOOSE CREEK BETWEEN PRAIRIE STREET AND BELLEVUE AVENUE.

CREWS WILL BE WATERPROOFING THE BRIDGE DECK. THE BRIDGE WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC 24 HOURS A DAY BEGINNING WEDNESDAY MORNING, SEPTEMBER 16. WEATHER PERMITTING, THE PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED WITHIN 10 DAYS AND THE BRIDGE REOPENED BEFORE THE END OF THE MONTH.

THE CITY OF OTTAWA APPRECIATES THE AREA RESIDENTS' PATIENCE DURING THIS TEMPORARY INCONVENIENCE AND THANKS THEM IN ADVANCE FOR THEIR COOPERATION IN USING OTHER ROUTES TO TRAVEL. THE BRIDGE WILL BE REOPENED TO TRAFFIC JUST AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
